Egyptian Masks

5th and 6th graders ended their social studies unit on Ancient Egypt with a hands-on, creative and colorful art project.

These beautiful masks, originally made of 22 pounds of gold and jewels, were part of sacred ceremonies and rituals. They symbolized the mystery and royalty of their gods. These faces brought fear to ordinary Egyptians of the unknown and the afterlife.

The most famous of all gold masks, the model for our 5&6 project, was the one belonging to Tutankhamun. In the fall of 1925, English archaeologist Howard Carter excavated the heavy sarcophagus and was the first person to see Tut's gold mask in 3,250 years. He was almost speechless with it's beauty.

We love beautiful things at APCS. Just look around at our students. So beautiful! We had so much fun making ornate Egyptian masks. We have incredible views of the forest and mountains from our classroom windows. We have a lovely facility with warm, interesting classrooms.
