Personal Supply (Please label with your child's name)

- Emergency Survival Kit
- 1" or 1 ½" white 3 ring binder with inside cover pocket
- Bible – a version that is easy for you to understand
- Spill proof water bottle
- Ear buds or headphones for computer
- 2 college ruled notebooks (Science & Social Studies)
- 1 graph paper notebook (Math)
- 2 composition notebook (Bible & Writing)
- Folder for returned papers (can be messenger style or 2 pocket)

Community Supply List (Do not label)

- Highlighters (thin size)
- Large pink erasers (no other colors, please!)
- Eraser caps
- 2 - 24 packs of pencils (No. 2) – any color
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 2 packs of college ruled paper
- 100 unlined 4x6 index cards
- Post it notes – 3x3 cube with 400 sheets

Desired for shared supplies, but NOT required

- White cardstock
- Any color cardstock
- Sharpies – any and all colors
- Markers/Colored Pencils/Crayons
- Mechanical pencils
- Scissors (regular size, not child size)

Emergency Kit

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The possibility of a major earthquake or other disaster in Washington makes it imperative that our students are prepared. If an earthquake or other disaster were to occur during the school day, the possibility exists that your child(ren) would need to remain at school for up to 72 hours. It is vital that you provide an Emergency Survival Kit for each of your children. You may purchase prepackaged kits from NCS or you may make your own.

Emergency Survival Kit:

The items listed below are for you to make your own kit:

- 3 – 8 oz. Juices (canned are better since cans do not break)
- 3 – 4 oz. Cans of fruit with pop tops OR three snack size packs of dried fruit
- 3 – Peanut butter or cheese & cracker type snack packs OR 3 granola bars
- 3 – Plastic spoons or forks, wrapped in napkins
- 3 – Individually wrapped moist towelettes (sealed)
- 1 – Solar blanket

A note and family picture

A note with your child's name, address, phone, parent/guardian's name, phone numbers, doctor's phone number

Please enclose the items in a one-gallon storage bag, with your child's name on the outside.

If your child requires daily medication, please contact the school to arrange a method of having the medication available in the event of an emergency.
