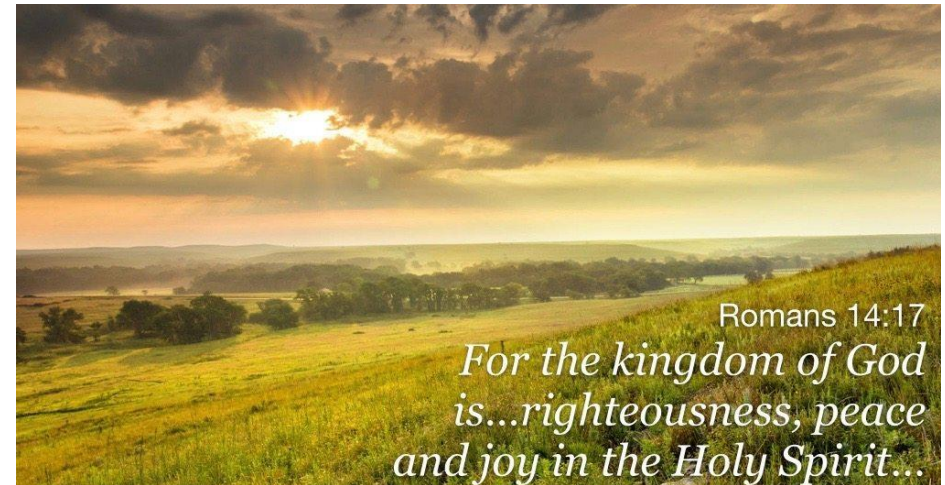
### *God's Expectations about My Body*
