I know you'll miss me too

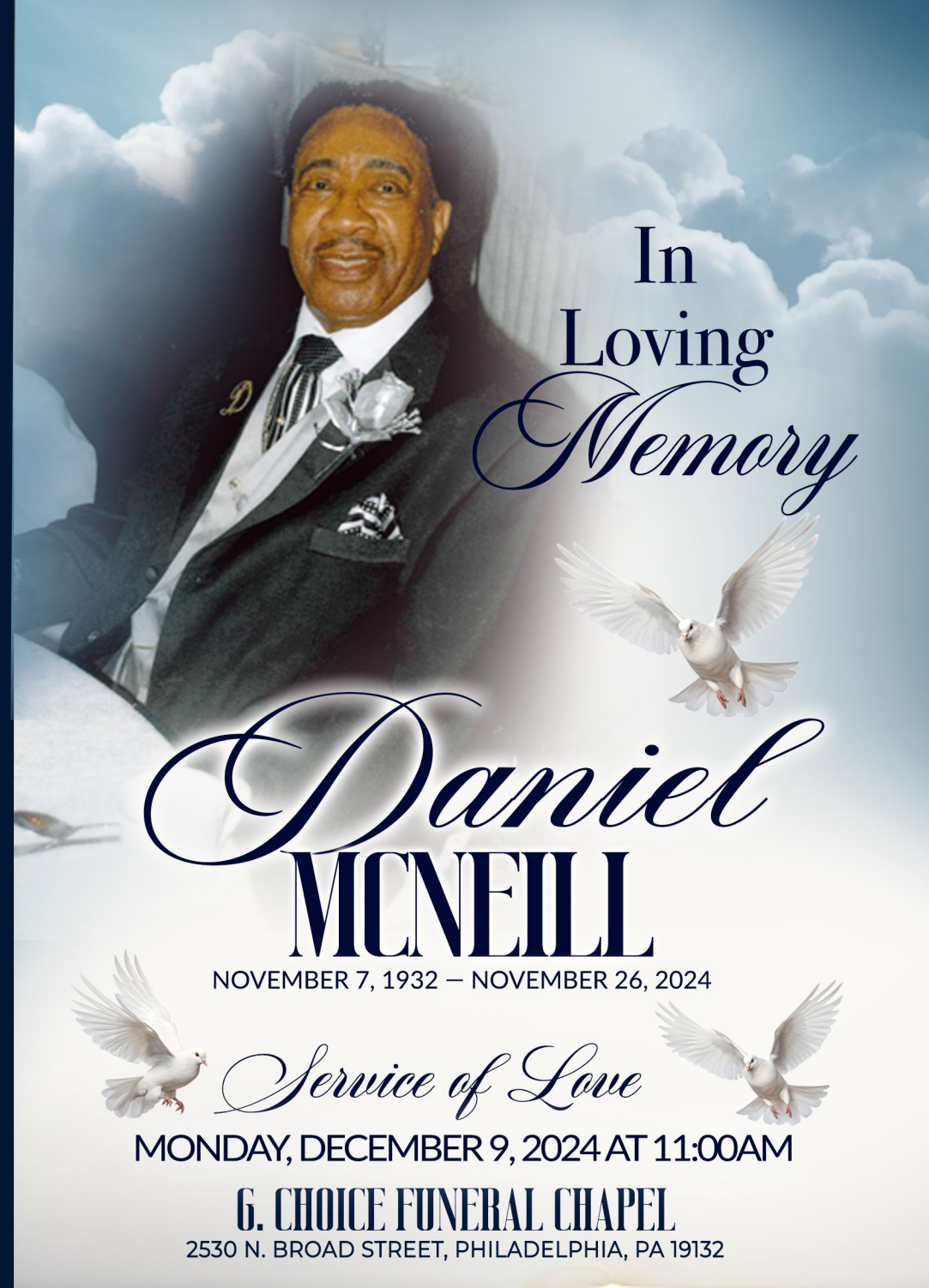
So when tomorrow starts without me
