# 1. UPDATE

FUNDING  
CHANGES

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Priority will be given to those schools that have **not** previously received funding as part of the Sporting Schools program.



## NEW GRANT PROCESS

- ▶ The schools that did not receive any grants are ranked higher
- ▶ Participation Ratio: total number of students that school gets active as opposed to the total student population
- ▶ Ensuring new schools are prioritised means that more young Australians can get activ

# NEW EQUIPMENT

## Basic Package

Features paddles and balls that are lightweight and makes delivery in schools easier. Affordable and the equipment can be used for other physical activity, bringing value to the school.

## Premium Package

Contains the standard package with racquets, line marking tape and markers.





# RAISING **AWARENESS**

- ▶ **Clubs**

- ▶ Noticeable lack of understanding from Squash facilities as to how to better utilise OzSquash to increase junior participation
- ▶ Creation of resources to support facilities to go out to schools and create long term partnerships





# THIRD PARTY PROVIDERS

## Pros

- ▶ Makes delivery of OzSquash easier in that workforce is readily available
- ▶ Easier to guarantee quality of program delivered

## Cons

- ▶ Does not have a vested interest in Squash – happy to deliver other sports
- ▶ Missing link between schools and clubs? Lack of transitioning of players
