



League Rules 2019/20

- 1. Players **MUST** be GSRA Members
- 2. Divisions 1, 2 & 3 are played on Thursday evenings and divisions 4, 5 & 6 are played on Wednesday evenings. All matches are played between 19:00 and 21:00.
- 3. The cost per cycle will be £30, season payment of £130 (5 cycles). All payments are non-refundable please see our refund policy on our website.
- 4. The scoring system will be as follows:

3-0 = 6-1

3-1 = 5-2

3-2 = 4-3

Players are responsible for entering their results online or sending them to office@guernseysquashandracketball.co.uk within 48 hours.

(scores should be entered on website as 3-0, 3-1, 3-2 etc.)

- 5. A Walkover will be awarded as **4-0**, at the league organiser's discretion.
- 6. The two highest scorers of each division will be promoted & the bottom two relegated. This may not apply if new players enter the league, or if the league has to be restructured due to timings etc.
- 7. If two players (or more) tie on the same points, relegation/promotion will be decided on how many matches that person has played, then the result between those players.
- 8. If you are unable to play your scheduled match please contact your opponent and the league organiser before midday on the day of the match. In the event the match is cancelled after this time, a walkover will be awarded to your opponent at league organiser's discretion. Please inform the league organiser of the rearranged time so that courts can be re-booked (included in the cost of the league).
- 9. If a player fails to show up to a match, or is more than 10 minutes late for a match,
 - i. The offending player will receive 3 penalty points.
 - ii. It is their opponent's choice whether to take a 4-0 walkover, or to rearrange the match when it is convenient for them.

- 10. If a player gives away two walkovers in one cycle due to no shows they will be withdrawn from the remainder of that cycle. ???
- 11. If a player withdraws from a cycle (through injury or otherwise) the following will happen:
 - i. If the player withdrawing has played less than half their matches in the cycle, all their scores will be deleted.
 - ii. If the player has played more than half their matches, the final results will be awarded as 4-0 to their opponents. Previous results will still be upheld in this case.
- 12. Players will be expected to referee at the times they are scheduled to do so. In the event they are unable to do so, it is their responsibility to find a replacement referee. Failure to do so will result in 2 penalty points, for every offence per cycle.
- 13. Players must wear their Jupiter Premier League T-shirt for ALL of their matches. Failure to do so will result in 1 penalty points for each offence.
- 14. All junior players will be expected to be wear eye protection at all times they are on court during the league.
- 15. All players will be expected to show appropriate conduct on court, the GSRA disciplinary committee will deal with any conduct issues, please see our disciplinary policy on our website.
- 16. Any complaints regarding the GSRA premier league must be directed to the league organiser. The Premier League Committee will deal with any disputes.
- 17. These rules are subject to change at any time throughout the 2019/20 season.
