Might cause you to stumble too

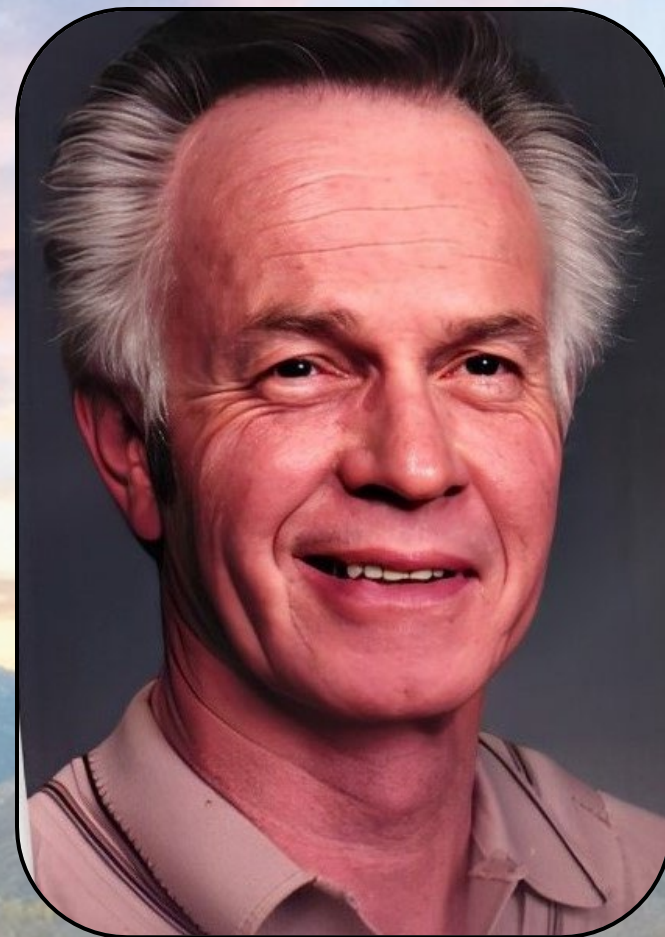
Don't sneer at the man who's down today
