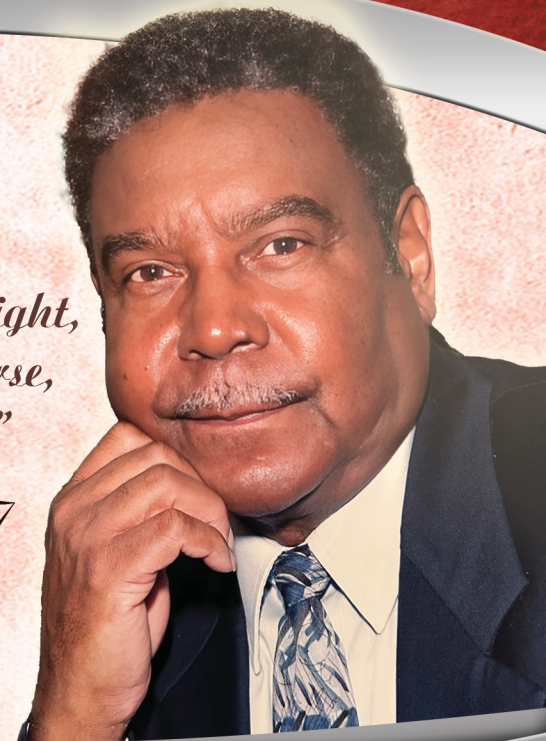

OBITUARY

Leroy Divinity, Sr. was born on May 22, 1937 and entered eternal rest on Tuesday, December 12, 2023, at the age of 86. He was a native of Copiah County, MS and a resident of Marrero, LA. Prior to making his permanent residence in Marrero, Leroy lived in Harvey, LA where he moved soon after graduating from Port Gibson High School in MS and upon his return from serving his country in the army. Back to civilian life, Leroy worked in construction and later for the Boeing Company for over a decade. In January of 2000, Leroy retired from Martin Marietta after 25 years. During his tenure at Martin Marietta, Leroy won the company's safety award many times for his outstanding job performance of keeping himself and his crew safe. In 1964, Leroy married the love of his life, Mildred. Even though both he and his bride of 59 years grew up in MS within 70 miles of one another, it was not until after they both moved to LA they met at a football game in Marrero not far from where they would later purchase a home and build their life together. Of all things they had in common, it was their love of Christ that stood out. Leroy accepted Christ at an early age and was a devoted member of the New Salem Church of Christ Holiness where he served as Chairman of the Deacon Board and sung in the Senior choir until the Lord called his faithful servant home. Leroy was preceded in death by his daughter, Marcy Annette Divinity; parents, Ernest Divinity, Velma Mason Divinity Wilson and Ellis Wilson; and brothers Cornell Divinity, Sr. and Ernest Lee "Moon" (Murl) Divinity. Leroy leaves to cherish his beloved memory: his devoted wife, Mildred Smith Divinity; sons Bishop Leroy (Pamella) Divinity, Jr. and Dexter (Angela) Henderson; daughter Darlene Divinity; grandchildren Israel (Jasmine), Leroy "Trey", Antonia, Deborah, Darnell (Candic); great grandchildren; brothers Joseph Bernard Divinity and Percy (Sylvia) Thomas; sisters Rosie Watts and Mary Harris and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives, church family, and friends.
