

We gather here, united in our grief, Seeking solace, seeking relief.


Let us remember the love she shared, The moments of joy, the way she cared. In our hearts, her memory will reside, A beacon of love, forever by our side.

Sadly missed, but never forgotten...

On September 11, 2000, in the city of Austin, Texas, Deshandrick Mitchell and Edward Rainey were given the charge to be parents to a beautiful baby girl, whom they named **Jasmine Ray Rainey**, sweetly known as "Ja Ja".

Jasmine attended the public schools of AISD. She obtained her education foundation from Oak Spring Elementary School then to Bedichek Middle School, moving up the ladder, she graduate from Aikens High School in 2019. Jasmine took advantage of every opportunity to get a good job, working and maintaining life skills. She was employed by the Social Security Administration, in the Disability Determination Services department at the time of her death.

Although Jasmine had no children of her own – she claimed Ashton, Kayden, Khalil, and Trinity, as hers, and they loved her dearly.


We have to keep our heads up and stay strong. The Lord our God did nothing wrong. When He called my (*Naenook*) Jasmine home.
