Aureon



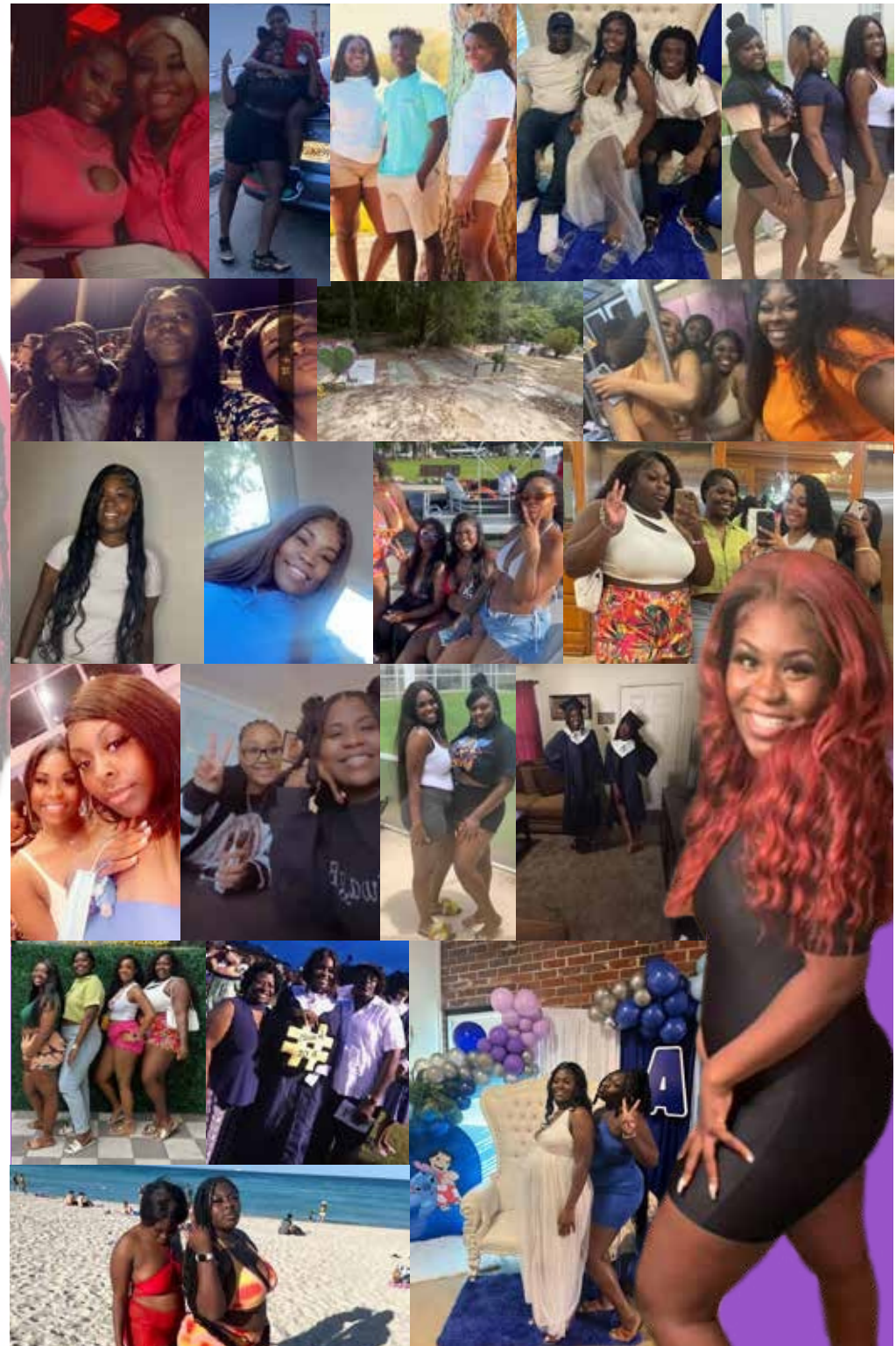
