

Three-Way EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

“In the highest sense the work of education and the work of redemption are one.” *Education*, p. 30. The Mountain View Conference embraces this theme and is cognizant of the significance of a Christian education. It is aware that the youth are the heritage of the Church; it is also alert to its role in providing such an education for all its youth.

The Conference is sensitive to the financial aspects of a Christian education. In order to enhance the prospects for all to obtain a Christian education, the scholarship fund has been established to assist students who qualify according to the guidelines. In line with this action, the following guidelines were adopted:

1. Procedure for scholarship request:
 - A. Application form must be approved by the local Church Board and accompanied by a check from the local church for their portion.
 - B. Request must be approved by the Conference Educational Assistance Committee.
2. Application form must list all sources of income for a family requesting scholarship funds - wages, investments, rentals, etc.
3. A scholarship of up to \$500 per semester received from the church may be matched by the Conference with participating colleges or academies according to their individual policies.
4. Since scholarship funds are limited, the Conference will determine the amount to be awarded each applicant according to funds available.
5. Parents are not permitted to contribute the major portion to the scholarship fund in behalf of their own children.
6. No employee of the SDA Church will be allowed educational assistance for his/her children, unless he/she is not eligible for the regular educational assistance.
7. A student attending a boarding school will be expected to work a reasonable number of hours (in most cases a minimum of 30 hours per month). The Office of Education reserves the right to check work record with the work supervisor.
8. The Conference Committee should allow for exceptions to various requirements where deemed advisable.

The Mountain View Conference, in cooperation with certain schools and colleges, has set up a STUDENT AID FUND to assist with Christian education. This fund is administered by the Conference on the following basis:

A contribution of up to \$500 per semesters for colleges or academies, received from the church may be matched by the Conference, and participating academies or colleges will assist according to their individual policies. The Conference has limited funds for scholarships. The Conference Educational Assistance Committee, therefore, will determine the amount to be awarded each applicant. Parents are responsible for the balance of tuition and miscellaneous expenses.

Checks must accompany applications approved by the church. Upon Conference approval the school, the church and the parents will be notified. Should the student for any reason fail to complete the semester, it is intended that an appropriate amount be refunded to the organizations which have participated. Applications must be submitted for each current semester.
