- Representatives of the Southern Maryland community

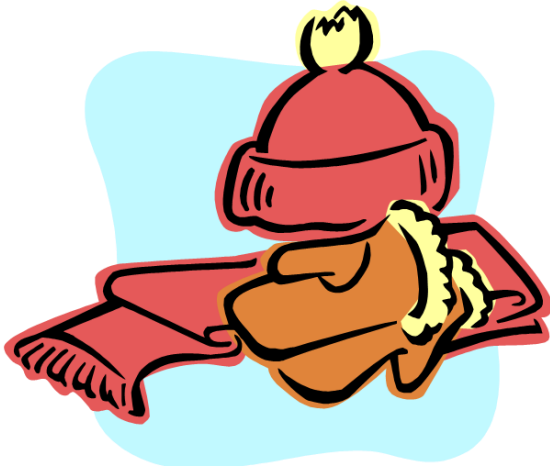


Followed by small group facilitated sessions to share our stories and make recommendations
