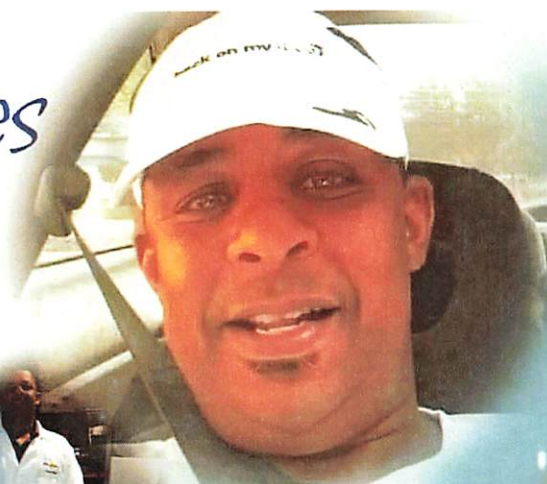

Lift your heart and share with me

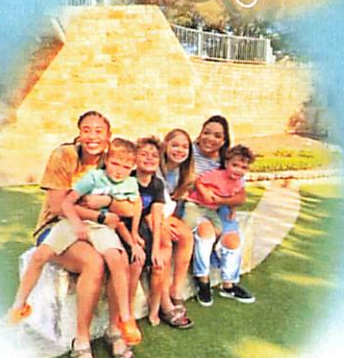
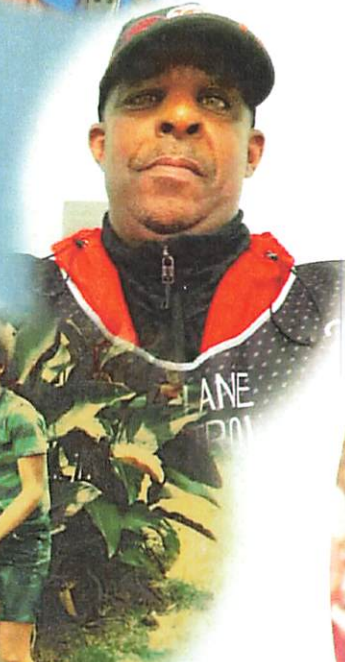
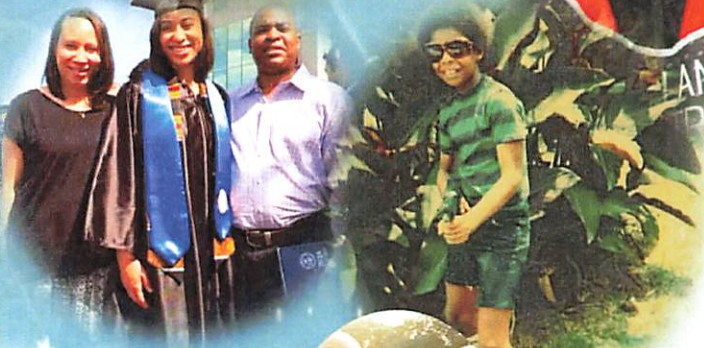
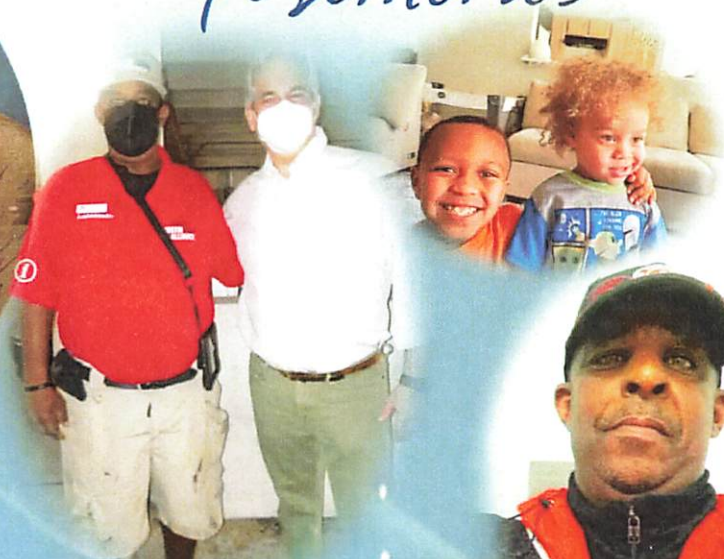
