Pastor's Note

A SPIRIT-MOTIVATED CHURCH

This year this bulletin space will be filled with materials drawn from a book written by Elmer Towns, Dean Emeritus of the School of Religion and Theological Seminary at Liberty University in Lynchburg, VA. It is entitled "I Am Jesus: Let's Change the World."

"God revealed these things by Spirit. For his Spirit searches out everything and shows us God's deep secrets." (1 Cor. 2:10, NLT)

I am Jesus who will send the Holy Spirit into your life and into your church. When you yield to the Holy Spirit and let Him control your life—and the life of your church—you will live and serve in a new experience of happiness and effectiveness. This book is about you being an exceptional follower of Me, so the first step is to ask the Holy Spirit to fill you (Eph. 5:18) and direct your daily life and service (Gal. 5:16, 25). Are you tired of striving for the things of outward satisfaction? Tired of trying to make a name for yourself and struggling to get ahead? Invite the Holy Spirit to control your life. Follow His lead and ask Him for power to do spiritual things you cannot do (Phil. 4:13).

When the Holy Spirit comes into your life, He not only will show you where you have gone wrong, He will show you the Father's plan for your life: "I know the plans I have for you...they are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope" (Jer. 29:11). Why don't you pray for the Father's plans right now; they may have been a secret to you, but the Holy Spirit will reveal them to you.
