Obituary

Shirley Bell Barfield was born on January 16th, 1945, in Saline, LA to Laura Bell and Roy Jackson Sr (Deceased).

Shirley attended Shady Grove High School and graduated with her diploma in 1963. She accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of her family church, St. Mary's Missionary Baptist Church, until she decided to relocate to Portland, Oregon. Shirley came to live first with her cousins Noemie Houston and then Nancy Smith. During this time, she was introduced to her loving husband James Oliver Barfield by her cousin's husband.
