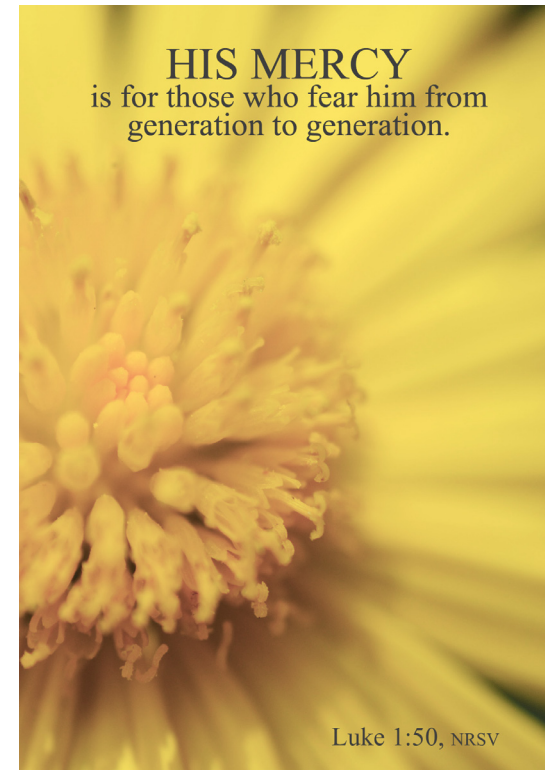

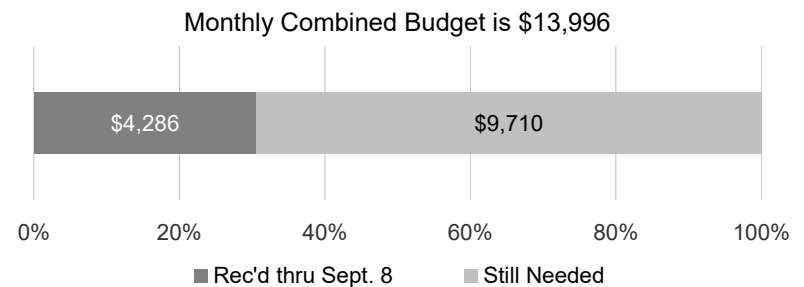
If you enjoy this lunch time together, please consider joining a team and help us continue this special time of fellowship.
