4.1.2 At the beginning of each match, the home team shall provide one new ball as approved by Squash NSW. Should the ball break or otherwise be replaced in accordance with the WSF Rules, the home team will supply a further new ball as approved by Squash NSW.

4.2.2 Premier Grade teams will use the PAR 11 point system. Sydney 1 teams will use PAR 15 point scoring system.
4.3.4 After Round 8, if a registered player has not played four (4) matches or three (3) matches where there is a bye then NO PLAYER can replace this player, until such time as the player has played that number of matches. eg if the registered no 1 does not play four matches then all registered players MUST move up a position and a reserve is permitted at the bottom of the team if required.
4.8.1 Any player wishing to play in the finals must have :

- Been a registered player for that team
- In a 6-key draw with 4 players have played six (6) rounds for the team OR five (5) rounds if there was a bye in that division
- In a 6-key draw with 3 players have played five (5) rounds for the team OR four (4) rounds if there was a bye in that division
- In an 8-key draw with 4 players have played six (6) rounds for the team OR five (5) rounds if there was a bye in that division
- In a 10-key draw with 4 players and only fifteen (15) rounds have played six (6) rounds for the team OR five (5) rounds if there was a bye in that division Note that playing multiple matches for a team in the same round does NOT count towards eligibility for the finals, nor does playing as a reserve for a different team
