

## **NAGVA SERVES**

From the Bright Star Foundation's website: Bright Star Foundation will also work to provide stable, affordable, and inclusive housing, and economic support to vulnerable people (especially in consideration of age, race, disability, HIV status, class, and other marginalized statuses) who identify as LGBTQIA+, located in the southwest, Nevada, California, Utah, Arizona, Oregon and New Mexico.

Bright Star Foundation owns and operates two four-plexes in an area near the Boulevard Mall, just off Maryland Parkway. The buildings have 17 bedrooms that are rented at subsidized rates in an effort to provide stable housing to individuals who might otherwise be homeless. Las Vegas has one of the highest rates of unaccompanied and unsheltered youth in the country and 40 percent of homeless youth identify as LGBTQIA.

There is an equally serious homelessness issue in the trans community and Bright Star also is working to help alleviate part of that problem.

The foundation offers repatriation assistance for youth who find themselves stranded, without a place to live in big cities, far from home, if there is a safe relative or friend that the young person can return home to live with.

Bright Star also assists with emergency help for youth without homes and coordinates with other homeless youth or LGBTQIA organizations, such as The Center, Shannon West and Nevada Partnership for Homeless Youth.

Please note that coolers are NOT allowed inside Mandalay Bay.



# Denise Summer Daily Nominated by Tia Thompson

Denise Summer Daily's volleyball career in NAGVA began with her debut in 1990 playing with the Latin Panthers of San Diego participating (and winning) in the San Diego, Los Angeles, and San Jose tournaments that year.

After her success in these tournaments, she was rated A and then up to AA. Denise played on a variety of teams throughout her NAGVA career and would win many more NAGVA tournaments for years. For Denise, it wasn't about the gold medals or trophies that ignited her spirit to play in NAGVA. She was getting the chance to see old friends and meeting new people who would become lifelong friends.

Denise started her transition to female in 1993. Although being trans back then wasn't as well known as it is today, she would become the pillar of black trans female athletes. She continued to play in NAGVA as a black trans until finally making the transition to the Open Women's Division in 2018 where she played with Hawai'i Titahz in the LAVO San Diego Spring Challenge where they took the silver medal. Later in the same year at the LAVO WSF tournament at UCLA, Denise and the Titahz won the gold medal. She continued to play in the Women's Division where she felt the most comfortable because she was finally playing with athletes who were just like her, cis and trans alike until her untimely death on January 23, 2022.

She made a tremendous impact on the NAGVA scene with her great ability to play, and of course, that big, bright smile with her wonderful personality. May she rest in Aloha

#### **Pool Play Schedules**

Pool assignments are subject to change, and we will try to communicate any changes with team captains. Captains are responsible for communicating with their individual members.

#### **Extra Player Fees**

Team Captains may log on to <a href="www.nagva.org/championships">www.nagva.org/championships</a> to pay any payments due for Extra Player Fees (team fee covers 8 players). The payment works just as it did when the registration fee was paid. If you have trouble paying your team's fees, please email <a href="mailto:treasurer@nagva.org">treasurer@nagva.org</a>. Zelle and cash payments can be made at registration, if needed.

#### **Rosters**

Waivers for the tournament will be finalized on Wednesday, May 25, 2022. Please ensure rosters and payments are updated NO LATER than Tuesday, May 24, 2022.

#### **COVID Protocols**

ALL players/spectators must provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID Test within 72 hours of signing the waiver. Accepted forms of proof: vaccination card, electronic/digital card, or a photo. In ALL instances, Name and DOB must be present on both "card" AND match ID to be valid. Masks indoors are highly recommended but are not mandatory unless required by city/state/facility rules.

**ACCEPTED COVID Test:** PCR or Rapid Test - Player will provide a printed document from the test provider or laboratory OR an electronic test result displayed on a phone or other device from the test provider or laboratory. Handwritten documents are not permitted.

**NOT ACCEPTED:** antibody tests, self-administered test at-home tests

Tickets are non-transferable, and ID is required at the banquet check-in.

#### Refereeing & Scorekeeping Assignments

All teams are responsible for refereeing four matches during pool play (2 on Friday, 2 on Saturday). Only certified referees can serve as referee, and only certified scorekeepers can serve as a scorekeeper. Also, during tournament play, your certified referee must act as the down referee. Remember to bring your own whistles. Failure to follow the rules may result in team penalties. Teams that do not have certified referees and scorekeepers will pay \$30 per position / per match.

## **TOURNAMENT**

#### **Rules of Play**

During Pool Play on Friday and Saturday, all matches will be 45 minutes long, which include a 5-minute warm-up. These matches will be two sets starting at 4 to 25, capped at 27. Matches will be timed and announcements on start and stop play as well as the 2-minute warning will be made throughout the hall on the in-house sound system speakers. No timeouts are allowed after the 2-minute warning but substitutions are permitted. If the score is tied at the end of play, the next point wins. If there is a protest, the match does not stop and protests are notated on the scoresheet at the time of incident and will be dealt with after the match. Results will be continuously posted throughout Pool Play and are available at, or near, the Command Center.

The Double Elimination tournament will begin for B and BB on Saturday night and for A, AA, and Women's on Sunday morning. Winner's bracket matches with best 2 out of 3, first two sets starting at 4 to 25, capped at 27. The third set will begin at 0 to 15 with no cap, switching sides at 8. Loser's Bracket matches will be best 2 out of 3 to 15, starting at 0, first two sets capped at 17 and third set no cap. If there is a protest during the tournament phase, stop play immediately and come to the Command Center where the protest committee will convene to rule on the protest. Some teams that win their final match on Saturday night may be reffing the 8:00 am match on Sunday. If you have any questions, please come by the Command Center before leaving the Convention Center Saturday evening.

Apart from the NAGVA rule exceptions, all USAV rules apply, including net touch and centerline violation rules (e.g. a player may cross the center line so long as it does not interfere with play (judgment call)). NAGVA does not allow pursuit.

The NAGVA sport court rule: a player must have one foot on the playing surface as the ball is played. The player may fall off the sport court after the ball has been contacted but the player may not touch another sport court. If contact with another sport court is made, the ball is deemed dead and the other team wins the point.

When serving, both feet must start COMPLETELY ON the sport court.

Please fill out all lineup sheets completely with names, NAGVA numbers and uniform numbers.

Sign all scoresheets and verify them when signing. All scores will be final once you have signed.

Uniforms MUST have clear and visible numbers on the front and back of every players jersey. These numbers MUST contrast the color of the uniform. The libero jersey MUST contrast the color of the rest of the team. We will ask you to change if these are not followed.

And please don't forget that ALL PLAYERS MUST SIGN THE WAIVER before stepping on the court.
