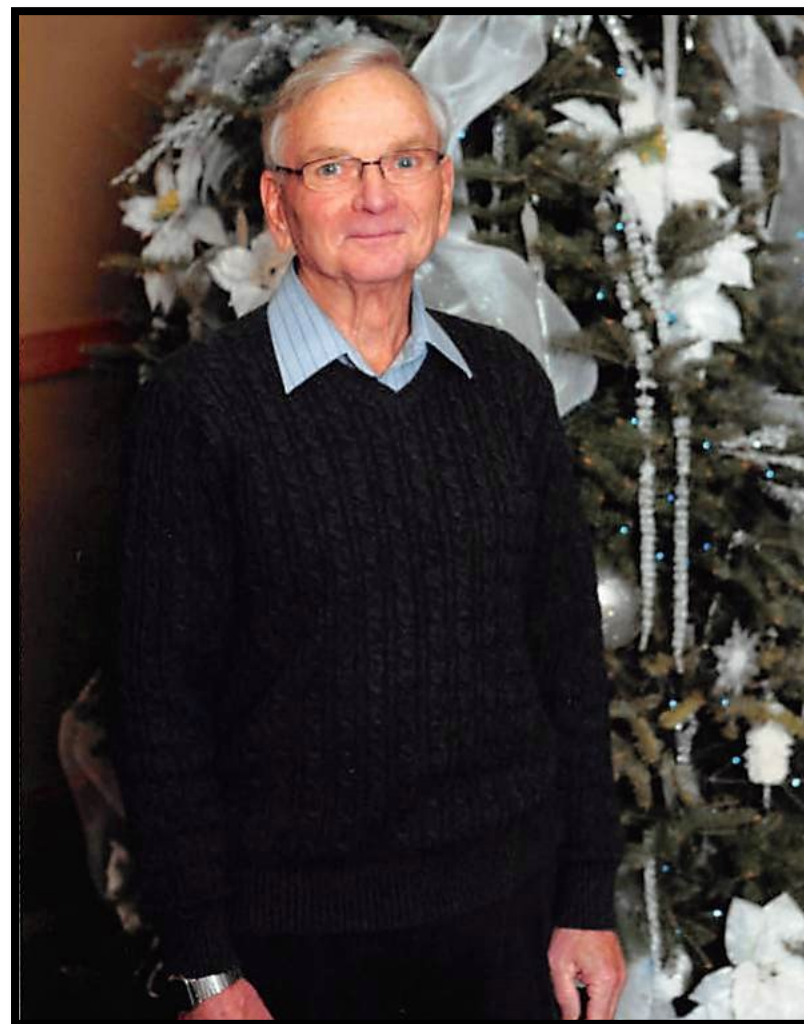




In Loving Memory Of

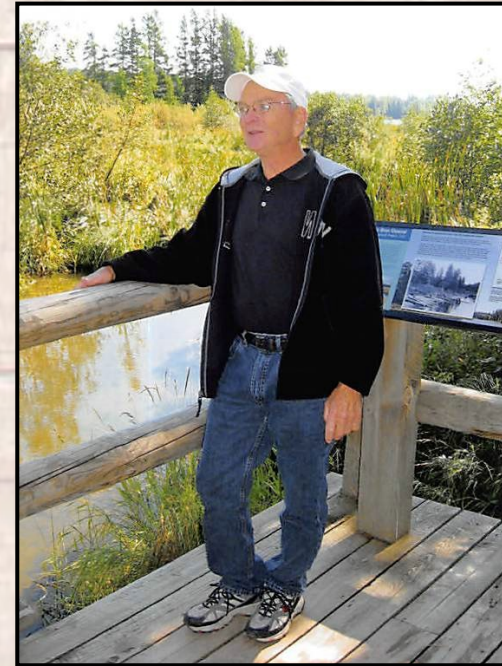
