

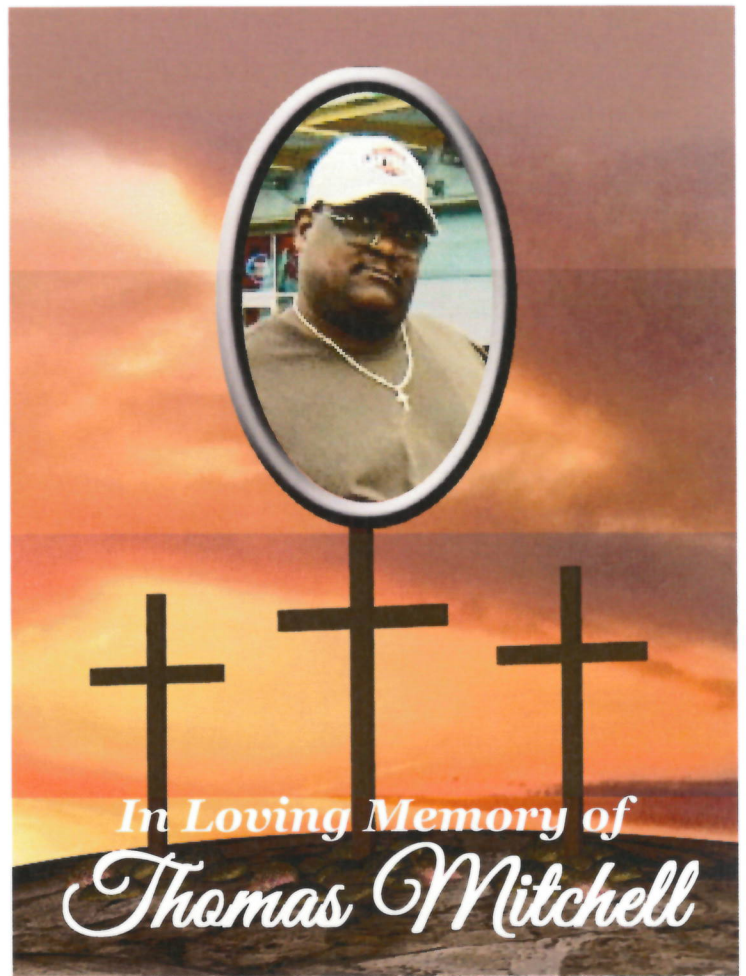
Thomas Mitchell

And when you left this world, A small part of me died.

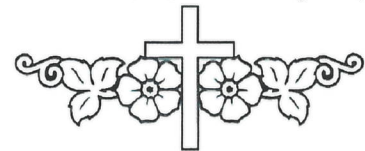
Your smile could brighten anyone's day,
