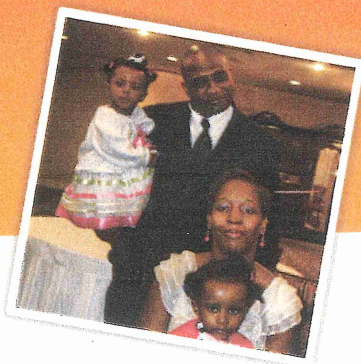
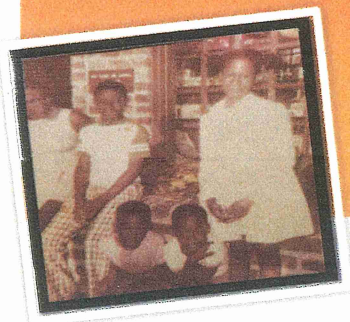


# Mr. Lucius L. Lawton III
