Rev Alan writes...

My Church Commitment - To Baptise











So far, I have written about our commitment to **Give**, **Serve** and **Meet** as part of our Parish Vision to grow in commitment to church: "Jesus' Family on Jesus' Mission". In our morning services, we continue to learn about what this means in our five areas of commitment to **Give**, **Meet**, **Serve**, **Baptise** and **Pray**. This week I am writing about our commitment to **Baptise**.

Baptism is a sign of membership of God's church. Jesus instructs us to baptise in his Great Commission, given before he ascended to heaven: *Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit* (Matt 28:19). We see the early church baptised new believers. The passage in Acts 2:41 records how on the day of Pentecost the first believers, on accepting the good news message from the disciples, were immediately baptised.

We may not all conduct baptisms, but we all have a part to play in sharing our faith to help bring people to baptism. That's our mission as a church! You'll see I've added the word **Share** to the Baptise



symbol. Our commitment to Baptise brings with it a commitment to share our faith with others. Maybe you know someone or have a child who hasn't been baptised? Or maybe you feel prompted to explore being baptised for yourself? If so, then let me encourage you to speak to a leader in your fellowship or contact the Parish Office and I'd be delighted to follow-up and arrange a baptism.

St Peter's has a rich history of baptism, or renewal/affirmation of baptism vows, by full immersion. We set up a baptism pool in church and hold a special service where anyone can be baptised for the first time or renew the vows taken on their behalf as an infant.

People who have been baptised in this way speak of the great joy as they take a step to fully embrace their faith and commit their life to God through baptism.

In addition, we can arrange a Confirmation by the Bishop - a special service to confirm your baptism vows. Joining an Alpha Course could be a good step towards baptism or confirmation.

For us all, baptism signifies our ongoing commitment to God as part of his church. The waters of baptism show of the cleansing power of God to forgive, set us free from the bondage of sin, and bring us new life. The Reformation theologian Martin Luther said: "remember your baptism every time you wash your face".

Baptism unites us as members of God's church, so let's commit to live out our baptism vows and share our faith with others.
