NEW MOVIES

JEREMIAH

The story of the Biblical Prophet and God's messenger just before Israel was conquered by Nebucandnezzar. A lovely movie, but please read the printed short story of Jeremiah that is inside the DVD case. It will help you better understand the movie story.

MULLY

The story of Charles Mully who as a six year old boy was deserted by his family. He took care of himself on the streets in Africa. By working hard as an adult he became wealthy, but the remarkable part of the story is what he did with his money helping orphans.

FREEDOM – Based on a true story

This is the story of two men, 100 years apart. The first, in 1856 is a slave who with his family struggle to get to freedom. The second, 100 years earlier, is John Newton, who is captain of a slave ship.

HEALED BY GRACE

The story of a girl, in a family who has multiple problems. She was sent to her grandfather, an old gruff horse trainer. Its fun to learn how they get along, how she learns about horses and how the family problems are solved.
