The following is in response to Ms. Yantorno's (nee Loaiza Villada) request for a course-by-course evaluation of her academic credentials from Colombia. This evaluation was prepared based on official original academic credentials.

Ms. Yantorno attended the Free University (La Universidad Libre) in Colombia from 1990 to 1995. Founded in 1923, the Free University is a recognized (accredited) institution of higher education in Colombia. In order to be accepted into the Free University, applicants must have the Bachillerato diploma and pass an entrance examination. This is the equivalent of graduation from a college preparatory program at an accredited high school in the United States.

Ms. Yantorno completed her studies in 1995 and was awarded the degree of Public Accountant (Contador Publico) by the Free University on May 31, 1996. This is the equivalent of the U.S. degree of Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting earned at a regionally accredited institution of higher education in the United States.
