

## Church Safety Plan

### *Before Leaving Your Home for the Church Building . . . .*

1. Fill in the Attendance Agreement Form<sup>1</sup>
2. Take your temperature and record it on the Attendance Agreement Form.
3. Bring the Attendance Agreement Form, a face mask, & hand sanitizer with you.

### *Before Entering the Church Building . . .*

1. Show your Attendance Agreement Form and facemask to whoever welcomes you at the door. If you don't have a facemask, you will be offered one.
2. Allow your forehead to be scanned in order to take your temperature again.
3. Place your Attendance Agreement Form in the drop box at the entrance.<sup>2</sup>

**NOTE: If you feel sick or have a fever at home – join us online. If you have a fever at the church entrance, you will be asked to join our online services.**

### *While Inside the Church Building . . .*

1. Greet each other without physical contact – no hugs, handshakes, or fist bumps.
2. Keep six foot distances between yourself and others, per city's requirements.
3. Use only pews designated for seating, allowing for three people per pew. Families of three or more can sit together using an entire pew.
4. Wear facemasks while in the building per city requirements. Exemptions exist for those who face coverings would cause impairment due to an existing health condition or disability.
5. The portions of the building open for access are the sanctuary, lobby, restrooms, and fellowship hall. Avoid the Gateway Christian School wing of the building.

### *For Parents with Children . . .*

1. Sorry there will be no children's Sabbath School classes nor Children's Church.
2. We will have a Children's Story during the worship service but the children will remain seated with you. Children will NOT collect any offering.
3. Children ages 2 and under do NOT have to wear a facemask.

### *When Using the Restroom . . .*

1. Where possible, allow one person in the restroom at a time.
2. Be sure to wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds.

### *After the Worship Service is Over . . .*

1. Attendees will be dismissed by row beginning from the back of the sanctuary.
2. Enjoy post service fellowship outside of the building instead of within the lobby.
3. There will be no visitors' meals or church fellowship lunches after services.
4. God forbid should you be diagnosed with Covid-19, please report your diagnosis to Pastor Jason Belyeu. Your identity will be kept confidential.

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<sup>1</sup> Make photocopies of the Attendance Agreement Form for future Sabbaths or request an emailed copy so you can print the form for future Sabbaths.

<sup>2</sup> The Attendance Agreement Form is your ticket for admission into the building. Should the church learn that someone with Covid-19 worshipped in our building, we will need to inform all other worshippers who were attendance on that same Sabbath of their potential risk for exposure.
