### Supplies for Grades 5-8

#### Classroom policies for this year

1. All pencils will be collected and sharpened for students. When a pencil needs sharpened, students will put it in a "Needs Sharpened" container and take a "new" pencil from the "Sharpened" container. **(Students may not use mechanical pencils.)**
2. All paper will be collected and will be distributed or retrieved from an appointed location when needed.
3. No supplies, backpacks, or notebooks are to be on the classroom floor at any time, unless teacher directed. Coats or sweaters may be hung neatly on the back of chairs if needed.
4. Tops of desks will be free of clutter. Any materials students are not using will be stored in their desks, or lockers if appropriate.
5. **DO NOT BRING A BINDER TO SCHOOL. There is no room for them in desks. You may use them at home for storing finished work if you like.**

#### Required Supplies

1. **Pencils-** 2 Boxes of 20 wood pencils, (to be collected)
2. **Wide-Ruled, Loose leaf Paper-** 2 packs (to be collected)
3. **Several Solid Glue Sticks**
4. **Scissors**
5. **Water Bottle** with a lid that closes
6. **Markers-** Large and Fine Point for art
7. **2 Small Storage Containers** for markers, scissors, colored pencils, and glue.
8. **2 Large Boxes of Tissues** (to be collected)
9. **2 Large containers of Lysol or Clorox wipes** (to be collected)
10. **Backpack**
11. **One pack of colored pencils (already sharpened or twistable).**
12. **Yellow Highlighters-** will be used for Wordly Wise lessons
13. **One journal notebook.**

#### Other Supplies you may want to purchase:

1. Lunch Box
2. Jump Drive (for computer use) if you don't already have one.
