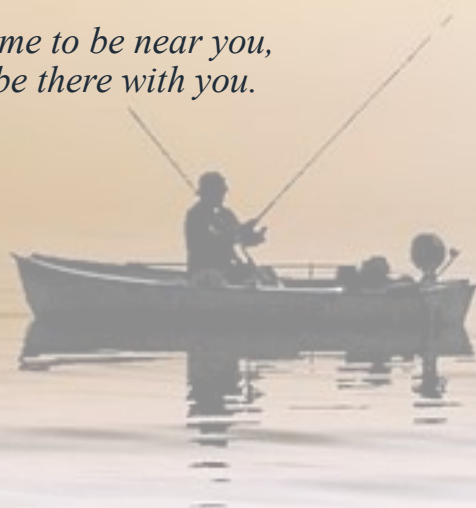
*Time for me to go now, I won't say goodbye;
