SURELY GOODNESS AND MERCY SHALL FOLLOW

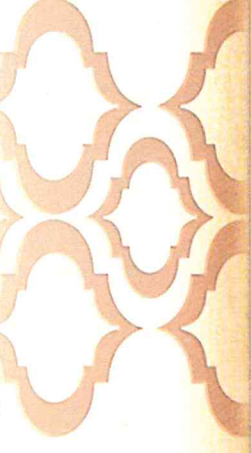
ME ALL THE DAYS OF MY LIFE: AND I WILL
