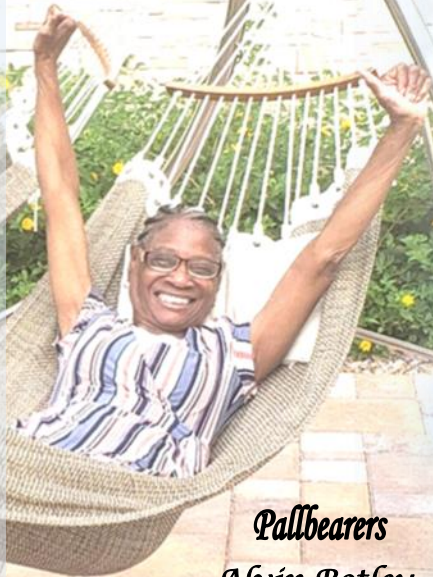


Acknowledgement
