Marian Elizabeth (Miller) Thompson, age 97, died on June 17, 2024, at Broen Home with family by her side. She was under the loving care of Moments Hospice. She enjoyed taking part in the many activities provided there and always felt loved and well cared for by the staff at Broen.
