

**Edwin Albert Holst,** age 87, passed away on December 24th at the Minnesota Veterans Home in Luverne, Minnesota, where he received compassionate, respectful, and dedicated care for nearly three and a half years.

Edwin was born on February 17, 1936, in Luverne, to Otto and Leona (Goehle) Holst. He graduated from Hills High School in 1954, where he lettered in basketball and football. He went on to lead a remarkable life dedicated to service, family, and community.

He served as the 5M Council Secretary for many years, embodying the Lions Club's motto of "We Serve." Also, Edwin served for many years as an elder and active member of Redeemer Lutheran Church in Willmar, Minnesota.

Edwin is also survived by his sister, Vivian Holst of Luverne; niece, Jana (Schiro) Schafer (husband Teal), and nephew, Justin Schiro (wife Stephannie); brother-in-law, Jerry Schiro (wife Sue); and his many loving cousins on the Holst and Goehle sides of his family. He will be fondly remembered by his extended family and friends.
