- **1099** – Statements provided for income other than wages, salaries, and tips

FINANCIAL AID REQUIREMENTS

The Cicero Church's student financial aid commitment is a conditional agreement based upon maintaining the following requirements:

Parents/Guardians will faithfully:

- Insure that their child is consistently on-time to school with limited absences.
- Meet their monthly tuition payment commitments to the school.

Students will faithfully:

- Attend school and all school functions.
- Complete assignments.
- Maintain satisfactory grade levels.
- Respect school property.
- Cooperate with teachers and other students.

Should these requirements not be met, student financial aid may be suspended.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

A primary goal of the Cicero Seventh-day Adventist Church is to provide an opportunity for all children to receive a Christian education. This is achieved through a cooperative effort between parents, church family, and students, to meet the financial requirements and maintain an optimum learning experience at our school.

For the 2018-2019 school year, the Cicero SDA Church will financially support through local offerings the Cicero Adventist Elementary School (CAES) by subsidizing over 50% of the school's operating expenses. The **actual** cost of tuition for each student is over \$4,600.00. The Cicero SDA Church's subsidy is what brings the cost down to \$2,800. The remaining expenses are covered by tuition. Parents/Guardians of students are responsible for these tuition payments.

For most parents with students in CAES, financial sacrifice is a reality. However, most would testify that as they cooperate with the Lord, He has partnered with them to meet their financial obligations. In some situations, ends still do not meet. When this occurs, parents may confidentially apply for financial aid provided by the Cicero Church family, through local offerings, to assist them in meeting their tuition commitment.

The Cicero Church's finance committee meets before each school year to prayerfully review all student financial aid requests. All applications must be received by the submission deadline to be considered.
