### From Pastor's Desk

The scripture for today **Micah 6:8**

"He has showed you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?"

God delights in the expression of His heart through the lives of His people. His desire is to have a people who reflect who He is. All of His requirements are for the benefit of those He loves. His purpose for us is to experience His love continually, to live in His love embrace. As we receive Him and the wonderful love relationship that He offers, He comes into our hearts and changes our lives.

God's requirement for man has never changed under the Old or the New Covenant. His requirements have always been directed at the heart of man and not the outward activities of man. The outward activities, even if they appear pious, do nothing to bring man into right relationship with God if the heart of man is not surrendered to God. If God is not living on the inside, the outward activities mean nothing. If God is living on the inside, however, the outward activities will reflect His presence in the life of the person with whom He abides. His presence produces justice, mercy and humble faith. These are not things which we create or have innately. They are the products of a life that is surrendered to God; a life that is in Him and by Him. Such a life is our portion as we receive His provision for us, Christ Jesus, and remain in Him, completely surrendered, completely empowered by His grace.
