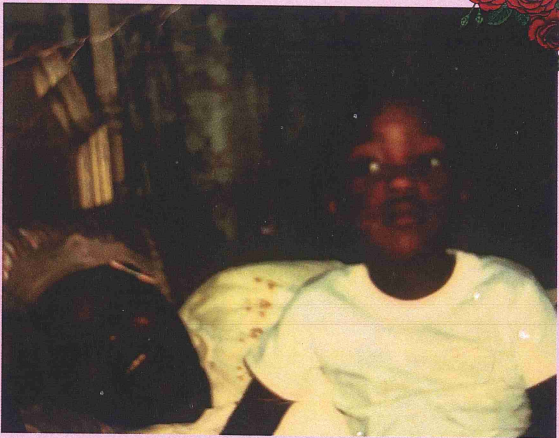
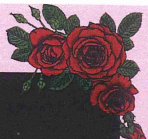
OBITUARY
