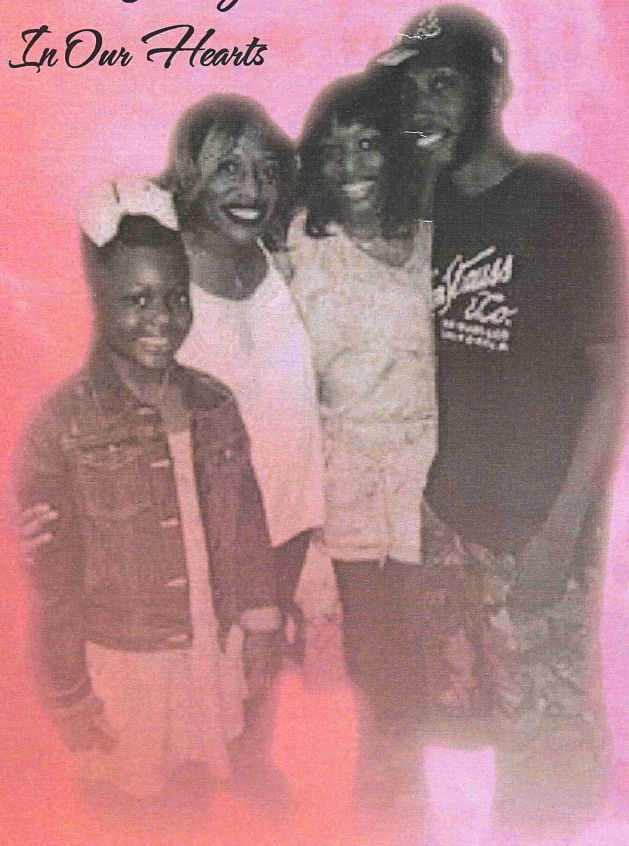

In the Special Missions Division of Gulfstream, Karlis earned the respect of her colleagues for her dedication and commitment to excellence.

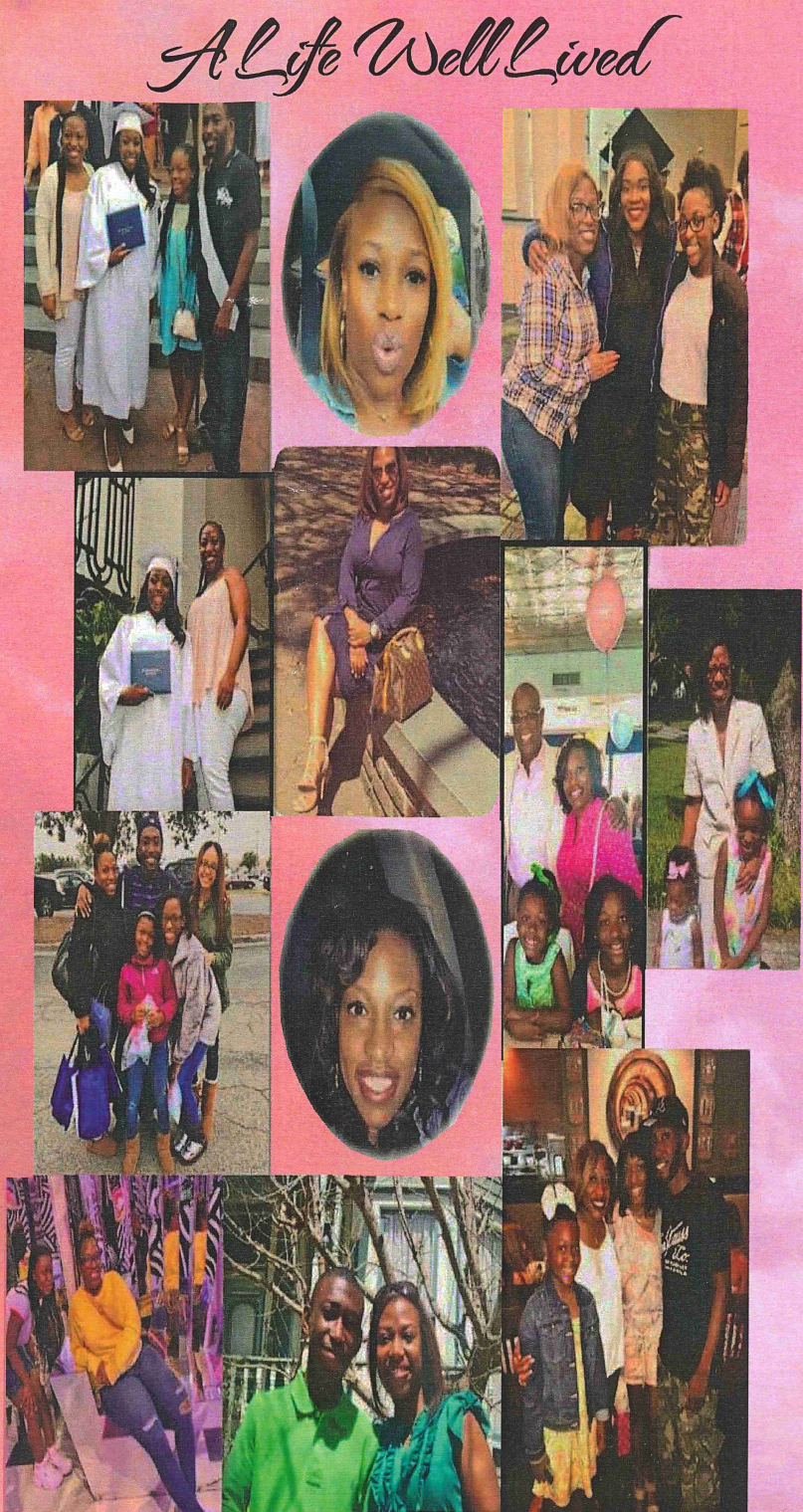
