

Gerrit John Van Den Top, son of John and Gerritje "Carrie" (Van Middendorp) Van Den Top, was born December 4, 1933, on a farm near Alvord, Iowa. On June 10, 1955, John was united in marriage with Mable Ter Meer in Inwood, Iowa. He was drafted into the United States Army with service at Fort Sill, Oklahoma and Karlsruhe, Germany from 1955 to 1957. Together the couple made their

home in Inwood until 1964 at which time they moved to Rock Valley, Iowa. John was a Rock Valley Community School Board member for 24 years.

John loved fishing and carpentry, and you would often find him in his woodworking shop. He built many homes in the Rock Valley area but was also an artisan who crafted intricate wooden vases as well as toys and barns for his many grandchildren.
