



To Braelin, Wassup B To Drevon, That's Wassup To Dionna, Sit down little girl, you are not my momma To DeAndre, I got you


This is my **"FAREWELL"**, this is not a **"GOODBYE"**

Love you forever, Lil Dre.
















Grandson from Ma-Maw "GRANDSON" You Good
