School Physicals

The state of New York mandates that any child applying for school for the first time and those entering grades **pre-K, K, 2, 4, & 7** are required to have a school physical. They are also required to have updated vaccinations. If you are one of the parent's that received a letter from the school about your child's physical, you have until **October 28** to get your child's physical. If you already have an appointment scheduled past the 28th, please let the school office know the date scheduled. **Physicals will be required in order to return to school after the 28th.**
