

Born on July 19, 1939, in Savannah, Georgia, he was known for his dedication and service in various aspects of his long life.


Willie attended Savannah State College (University) and also enlisted in the United States Marine Corps, where he served his country with pride. His military service were a source of honor for him throughout his life.
