Your Child's papers from the **previous day** are graded and put in his/her folder every morning. Looking at your child's work and talking to them about it regularly will help their learning—**ESPECIALLY in MATH**

Spelling tests are on Friday. We practice every day but your child may need more practice than that. Look for the preview paper that comes home on Tuesday or refer to the note sent home that included all the spelling lists for the next 4 or 5 weeks.

Reading Logs are due every Friday. YOUR CHILD must be reading to you a minimum of 75 min. a week. The books should be easy and your child should read them fluently. Does your child often see you reading the Bible, books, magazines, and newspapers? Talk about what you read. Your child will reflect what you value.



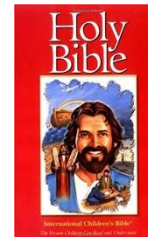

☺ **Treasure verse quiz next Friday, September 25:**

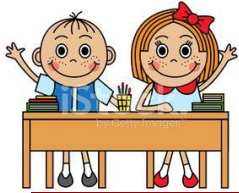

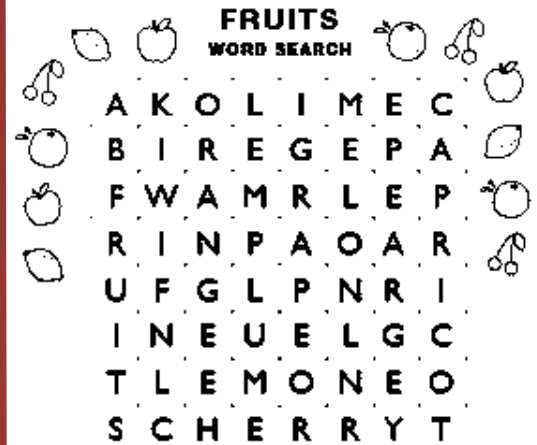
