On February 10<sup>th</sup> we made the long drive to the city where we will do our language learning. We took the "scenic route" which ended up being much more scenic and adventurous than we were planning on! The past two weeks have been full of looking at numerous apartments and starting language classes. Praise God we found an apartment last Friday! Thank you so much for your prayers for our housing. We are looking forward to finally being able to unpack our bags! Our language classes have been very challenging and a new way of learning for us. The language school is using the Growth Participant Approach (GPA) which focuses on learning the language in much the same way an infant learns. Just this week our language teacher (called a "nurturer") told us that we have been catching on very quickly and she has been giving us more intense and involved lessons than she typically would for Level 1.

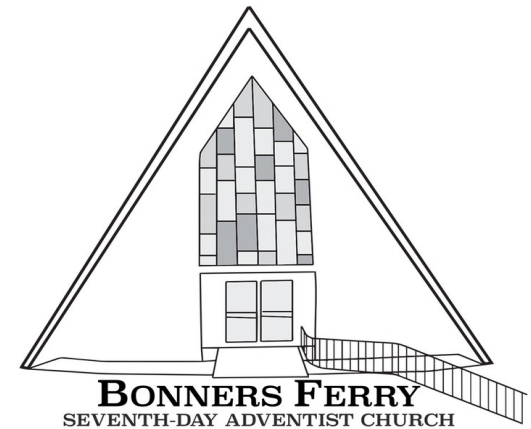
