## *The Pastor's Blog*

Today, we return to the full complement of pastoral staffing that has been the operating pattern of the Ottawa Adventist Church - our church - for over a decade. With that, I say to our new Assistant Pastor, Daniel Innocent, welcome as we enter a new chapter and phase of ministry in our church by his coming on board.

Without reservation, as a church family we will embrace and support him as he is led by the Holy Spirit in the fulfilment of the call he answered to ministry. In view of this objective, I cannot help but reflect on the sermon that was preached by Pastor David Rogers last week. Sermons can easily go in one ear and out the next so, should we have forgotten the title of the message, it was "*Love Thy Neighbour.*"

To be truthful, at first I could not see how the title was related to the theme of "*Our Seniors, Our Legacy,*" but as Pastor Rogers spoke, I realized that what he was saying was that there are intergenerational relationships in the church that must be nurtured if our mission as the body of Christ is to be real. I sat on the edge of the bench as Pastor Rogers called out areas that our seniors could do better in, and at first I was thinking maybe some of this could be upsetting to our seniors as he encouraged them to learn to use social media in direct terms. Then he turned around and did the same thing to our youth, highlighting areas in which they could be better, more receptive and respectful to our seniors. Finally, I could let that breath out! It was clear to me that if we are to be a community of Christ, then we all have work to do in going outside of our comfort zone so that we could truly achieve what it means to "*Love thy Neighbour.*"

So as a member of this church, the part that I play in loving my neighbour includes.....(you finish it!). What the Ottawa Adventist Church will look like depends on what we write in reflections as we begin a new chapter. Don't be too hasty in finishing this line as that could be a sign that you haven't given it much thought. If you already know the answer that could be a sign of loving **yourself**, as loving one's neighbour involves the hard work of dialogue, walking in the other person's shoes, faithful compromise and fervent prayer.
