From Pastor’s Desk

The scripture for today is **James 1:25**

“But whoever looks into the perfect law of liberty, and continues in it, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.”

The moral law of God is one of the most misunderstood things among those who profess to be His followers. The Bible says, "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple." *Psalms 19:7* The apostle Paul wrote, "Therefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good." *Romans 7:12* "For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin." *Romans 7:14* God did not create us in sin but in righteousness. He also gave us the freedom to choose so that we could love Him just as He loved us. Unfortunately, we chose to reject the law of God and the character of God and instead followed the law of sin and death. Disobedience to God's law is a clear indication of who is in control of our lives. No one whose life is surrendered to God can live a life of conscious disobedience to the law of God. Through the surrender of our lives to Christ, the life of God is expressed in us by the Holy Spirit of God Himself. It is not our obedience that saves us, it is our surrender in faith to His grace that saves us, and the evidence of a surrendered life is loving obedience to the one who loves us more than we can imagine. We are changed into the very glory of the Lord as we, through surrendered lives, embrace the perfect law of liberty that is given in His word and is written in our hearts. Through grace we look into the perfect law of liberty, and continue in it, being not forgetful hearers, but doers of the word. And "this man shall be blessed in his deed."
