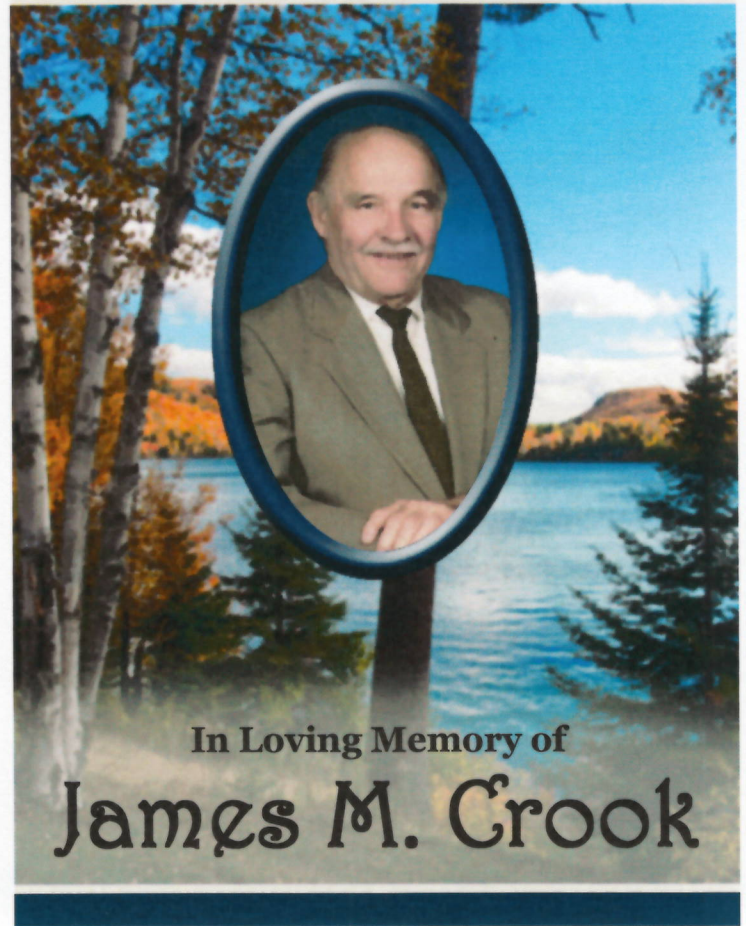


James M. Crook, passed away on April 23, 2021 in New Brighton, Minnesota.
