I asked for *Favors...*

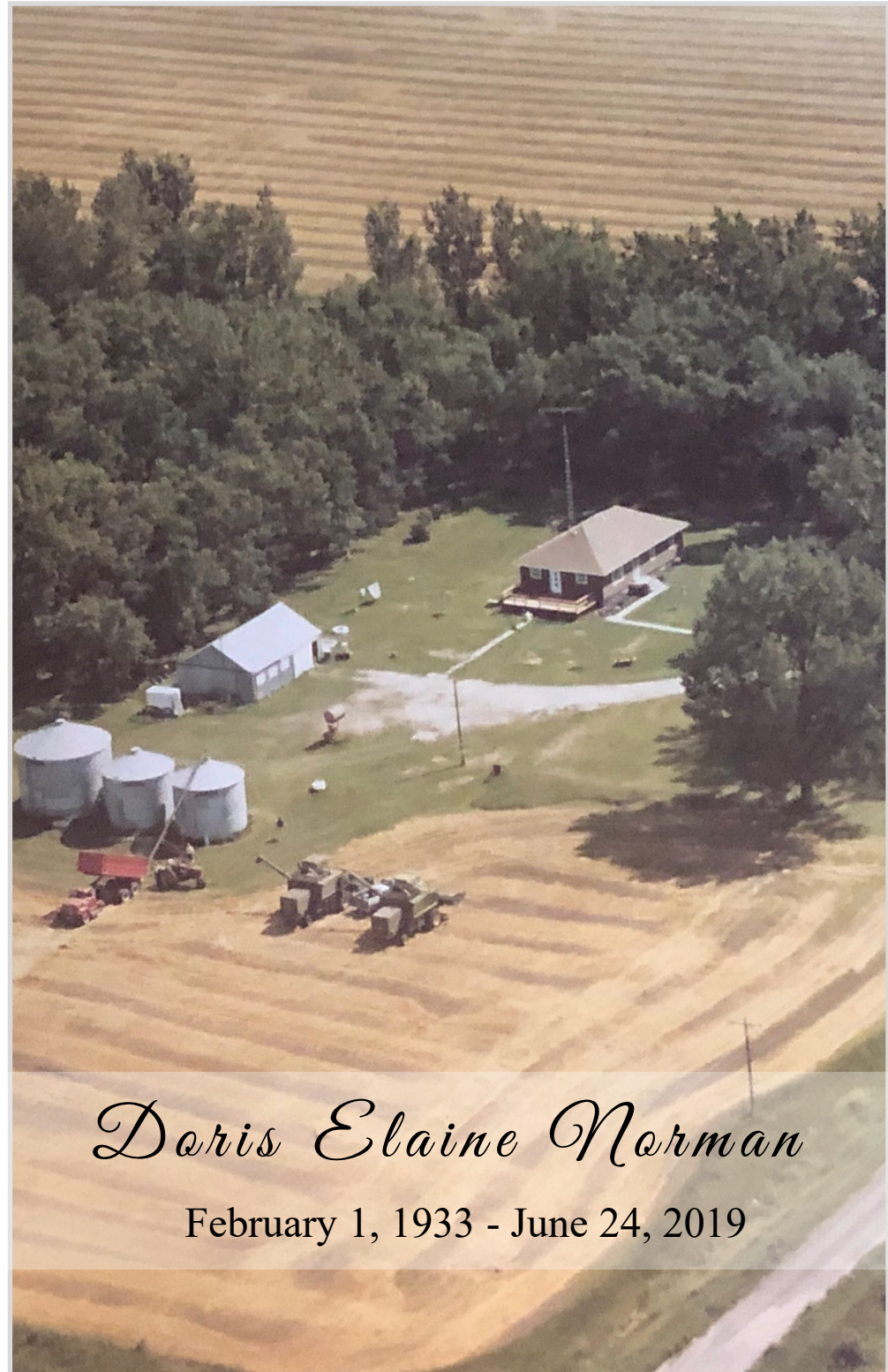
And God gave me Opportunities.
