Performance Development Coaching Course

Squash Australia will be holding the first Performance Development Coaching Course from 9-14 December 2019 at Carrara Indoor Sporting Complex.

A Performance Development coach is competent to plan, conduct and evaluate advanced training programs suitable for players competing at Australian Open Championships (or higher) level competitions. The Performance Development Coach should have the experience and knowledge to provide coaching leadership and serve



in a mentoring or educational role to assist Foundation, Club and Talent Development coaches.

Some of the key concepts of the course include:

- Build on Content from Club Development (Heavy on Perception and simple rallies) and Talent Development (On decision making / accuracy & Skill) to focus on tactics / applying pressure / engineering rallies / perturbation / action / deception to complete the picture

- Physiology tailored to Squash

- Energy Systems
- Nutrition
- Important Physical skills
- Developing Physical Skills
- Programming / Periodisation / Macro cycles, Meso cycles and Micro cycles
- Fitness testing


- Psychology to allow coaches to develop

- Their own people skills
- Perception / decision / Action
- Anxiety / Arousal / Stress /Pressure / Emotional Control / Goal setting /
- Relaxation
- Concentration
- Self-talk
- Visualisation

To be eligible to attend the Performance Development Coaching Course, a couch must have held a Talent Development Coaching Accreditation for a minimum of 12 months

Club Development Coaching Course

Carrara Squash Centre will be holding a Club Development Coaching Course from 19-20 October 2019.

After completion of the course, the coach will be competent to plan, conduct and evaluate training programs suitable for the diverse range of ages and abilities found among registered club players. Club Development is the accepted standard for coaches implementing a diverse Squash Club/Centre program. The manual for the Club Development programs include basic information on the game of Squash, warm-up information including lots of warm-up games, coaching points of each skills, drills and activities for each skill and suggestions for changing each activity to suit the players' ability, modified games and strategies.

Candidates would be required to show completion of the following in order to gain accreditation at the Club Development level:

- Community Coaching General Principles course online at https://www.sportaus.gov.au/coaches_and_officials/coaches
- Working with Children Check (through State Government)
- ASADA Level 1 anti doping course online at https://elearning.asada.gov.au/
- Squash Rules exam (multiple choice) During Course
- Read through and gain understanding of course content (including philosophy, coaching tools etc.) on eLearning platform and during course in person
- Practical assessment of knowledge and application of coaching tools during course in person
