18. REPORT FROM CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING ON JULY 11, 2018: As reported in the last newsletter, we need to replace our deteriorating water system. We found a large leak in one of the cast iron pipes, under the parking lot, that supplies water to the back bathrooms, baptistery, and kitchen and downstairs bathrooms. Because of this, the water system committee contacted 4 companies. Their report was presented by Robert Usery at the Church Business Meeting. It was voted to hire Redlands Plumbing to do this work at a cost of \$65,000. We will continue to turn off the water at the church, except on Sabbath, until Redlands plumbing can be scheduled to do the work sometime in August.

With the removal of part of the parking lot to do the water system, we looked at resurfacing the parking lot also. The last time the parking lot was worked on was 2014. So the committee contacted 3 companies and the results were presented at the Church Business Meeting. It was voted to replace a good portion of the parking lot that has deteriorated and seal the entire parking lot with a new material consisting of crushed lava and a binding agent. The company that was approved is Titan Contractors. The cost is approximately \$85,171.36 plus permit fees. This will be completed after the water system is re-piped.

Once again we will borrow the money from ourselves, with interest, and we will need to pay the accounts back. We want to thank all our members who have participated in moving these projects forward and all those who will financially support the upgrading of our almost 50 year old church.

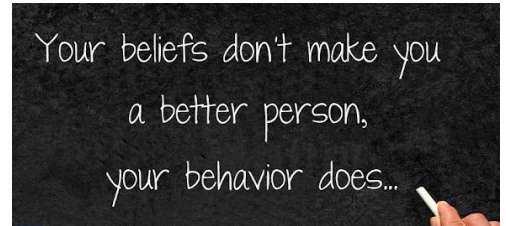
