### PSA COMMENTARY

Q Squash have set the date for the 2019 Queensland Open. It will be held from 31st October to 3rd November. The Cairns International will follow 1 week later: 7-10 November 2019.

Our players have been heavily involved in playing doubles over the past month. Firstly, many combinations had a Doubles warm up by playing in the Australian Doubles in preparation for the World Doubles Championship. Both events were played at Carrara.

It was a clean sweep to Queensland with Zac Alexander & Tom Calvert winning the Men's title, Rachael Grinham & Melissa Martin winning the Women's title and finally, Rachael Grinham & Jordan Till winning the Mixed.

The World Doubles Championship saw Queenslanders secure 3 silver and 1 bronze medal. Zac Alexander teamed up with Rex Hedrick to take silver in the Men's Doubles. Jessica Turnbull teamed up with Sarah Cardwell to take silver in the Women's Doubles and Ethan Eyles teamed up with Christine Nunn to take silver in the Mixed.

Zac Alexander and partner Alex Haydon won Bronze in the Mixed Doubles.

To round out the month, most of our players played in the Australian National Championships. The only bright note for Queensland was Jessica Turnbull winning Bronze in the Women's Closed.


