homas John Kaye was born on November 8, 1949, in Morris, MN, to James and Luella (Jones) Kaye. He grew up in Morris and graduated from Morris High School with the Class of 1968. Tom was an exceptional football player and was offered several scholarships to play college football. With the looming draft, he decided to join the United States Navy voluntarily so he could choose the field to pursue, working on fighter jets, which he really enjoyed. While in the Navy, he was stationed in Virginia, Tennessee, and Texas.

Following his honorable discharge from the Navy in 1972, Tom moved back to Morris. He worked as a carpet installer for his father and older brother's store.


