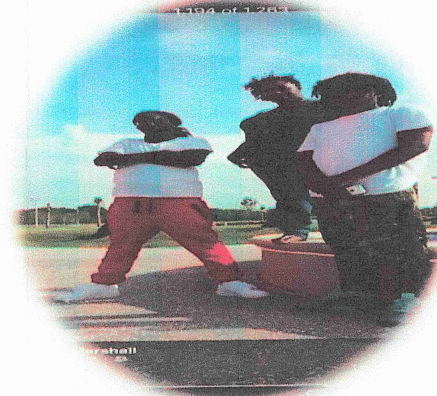

 All the days of my life; And I will*

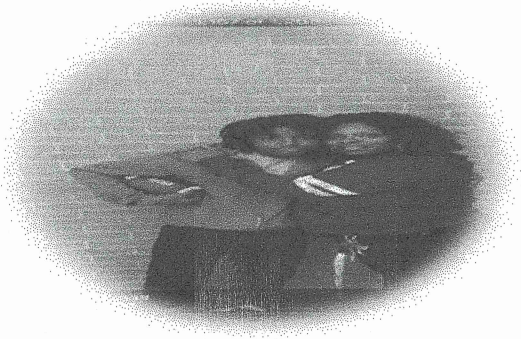
